with an annual information technology budget of about 20 billion and tens of billions more budgeted for technology embedded in sophisticated weaponry the department of defense dod relies heavily on software intensive systems to support military operations and associated business functions such as logistics personnel and financial management one important determinant of the quality of these systems and thus dod s mission performance is the quality of the processes used to develop acquire and engineer them recognizing the importance of these processes to producing systems that perform as intended and meet cost and schedule commitments successful public and private organizations have adopted and implemented software systems process improvement spi programs 1

the dod relies greatly on contractors to support its current operations and is likely to continue to depend on contractors in support of future operations as of dec 2009 dod estimated that over 207 000 contractor personnel were supporting operations in iraq and afghanistan dod expects to increase the number of contractors as more troops deploy to afghanistan this testimony addresses 1 the challenges dod faces when trying to provide management and oversight of contractors in iraq and afghanistan and 2 the extent to which dod has made progress in institutionalizing a department wide approach to managing and overseeing operational contract support charts and tables

the nation's technology base a workforce with robust science technology engineering and mathematics stem capabilities is critical to sustaining u.s. preeminence today however the stem activities of the department of defense dod are a small and diminishing part of the nation's overall science and engineering enterprise assuring the u.s. department of defense a strong science technology engineering and mathematics stem workforce presents five principal recommendations for attracting retaining and managing highly qualified stem talent within the department based on an examination of the current stem workforce of dod and the defense industrial base as outlined in the report dod should focus its investments to ensure that stem competencies in all potentially critical emerging topical areas are maintained at least at a basic level within the department and its industrial and university bases

dod continues to take steps to comply with legislative requirements and related guidance pertaining to its business systems modernization high-risk area in particular on march 14 2008 dod released a new version of its bea and issued its annual report to congressional defense committees describing steps taken and planned relative to the act's requirements among other things the steps address several of the missing elements that we previously identified relative to the legislative provisions and related best practices concerning the bea enterprise transition plan and investment management and continue to address the act's requirements relative to business system budgetary disclosure and certification and approval of systems costing in excess of 1 million however additional steps are needed to fully comply with the act and relevant guidance the latest version of the bea resolves several of the architecture gaps associated with the prior version such as adding business rules and data attributes however like the previous version its focus is largely on dodwide corporate policies capabilities rules and standards while these are essential to meeting the act's requirements this version has yet to be augmented by the dod component organizations subsidiary architectures that also are essential to meeting the act's requirements and the department's goal of having a federated family of architectures dod has taken some steps toward extending its architecture through its recently updated federation strategy however the military departments architecture programs remain immature particularly those of the army and the navy to address these challenges we have existing recommendations that dod has agreed to implement once these challenges are addressed the federated bea should provide a more sufficient frame of reference to optimally guide and constrain dod wide system investments

today and in the foreseeable future military operations require u.s. personnel to work alongside multinational partners and among local populations the dod has placed a greater emphasis on transforming language and regional proficiency capabilities which includes cultural awareness this testimony summarizes recommendations on dod's efforts to develop language skills and regional proficiency and the steps dod has taken to implement these prior recommendations specifically the testimony addresses the extent to which dod has 1 developed a strategic plan to guide its language and regional proficiency transformation efforts and 2 obtained the information it needs to identify capability gaps and assess risk
