as a life long christian that has had several mistakes and shortcomings carroll felt god leading her to put together a devotional book to reach those that don't fit in the positive encouraging definition many hurts and pains both self inflicted and inflicted by others can hurt our perception of god using bible verses as examples carroll put together a series of devotions for those that are less than perfect

this book is about a woman who had come to america from kashmir india she had no knowledge about american culture or american justice system she was married in india and her husband brought her to america in america her husband started abusing her being culturally abundant she kept taking abuse on daily basis and kept lying about her bruises and cuts to those who were asking her questions about her injuries abuse got worst to the extent that one day her husband tried to kill her she gained her consciousness after couple of hours when her husband decided to dump her body in the park somehow in the morning she managed to escape with her two children she went to a woman's shelter where she lived for six months in the shelter they insisted that she had to go to the court to get restraining order for her safety in that process her children were taken by the court and were given to that abusive man from whom they had a narrow escape she was forced to pay child support when she had not taken even a one cent from her home or from her

husband after she left her two children were given to their father because she was going to school judge punished her and her two children for trying to establish their life her children suffered the most because of the justice system i wrote this book for two reasons one reason is to tell my children especially my son that i am very sorry for taking my case to american justice system because his father has kept him in fear even my son is adult now but his father is still treating my son like he was treating me and my son is kept in a lot of fear stress and extreme tension his father didn't let him complete his education if he had encouraged my son to complete his education then he wouldn't be able to control my son's life that is tearing my heart every day and second reason is that i want to help a battered woman and their children by telling them my story i was a very private person but that didn't help me every battered woman of this country should know that when a man hit his wife is not love it is a danger sign figure out on time about safety zones for self and for children my story will guide them to be strong enough to help their children

we assume men grow up but do they dr jim wilder contends that many men never fully mature because they fail to negotiate the passage from boyhood to manhood an almost equally tragic trend occurs when men never make the transition to grandfathers and elders in their families churches and wider communities

the news media was driving everyone crazy it started with y2k then the bush gore presidential election controversy the clinton pardons the september 11th attacks and the anthrax letters wars subsequently ensued against afghanistan the taliban al qaeda and iraq but not without fierce exchanges with the united nations sex and financial scandals erupted involving the catholic church and wall street massive layoffs soaring debt and skyrocketing college tuition added to these the media never missed a beat was there no escaping them the nation's capitol in commemorating last years september 11th attacks was also preparing for an upcoming mayoral election the current incumbent was expected to breeze toward reelection but what followed seemed like a page out of william shakespeare's comedy of errors this prompted a virtual unknown to launch a comedy contest to provide some comic relief for the city from this onslaught of negative news only four contestants remained to compete for the prize money however only archie harris one of the four finalists showed up at the finale more bad news what will happen now find out by reading post 9 11 african american style laughter still da best medicine

in fiji's transnational pentecostal networks karen j brison examines the harvest ministry an independent fijian pentecostal church that sends fijian and papua new guinean missionaries to east africa southeast asia europe and elsewhere after studying the ministry's main church in suva for several years brison visited its missionaries and their local partners in east africa and papua new guinea the result of those visits this book provides an unusual insight into pentecostal churches in the global south arguing that they seldom produce novel visions of christianity and world inequality it also offers new perspectives by situating pacific island churches

within a global community and by examining social class formation which is increasingly important in the pacific pentecostalism has a consistent culture all over the world but shared themes take on different meanings in the face of local concerns in fiji pentecostal churches are part of middle class projects constructing leadership roles and highlighting transnational ties for a growing group of indigenous urban professionals in papua new guinea church leaders promote the idea that youths with blocked aspirations are tough and humble and therefore make invaluable missionaries in east africa pentecostal churches are part of a networking strategy that entrepreneurial individuals see as essential to survival as these local groups each use pentecostalism to advance their own agenda they endorse euro american racial stereotypes and ideologies about social evolution and progress

in this volume krishnamurti takes great care to elucidate this necessity of a revolution within our consciousness where the problem lies before we expect any kind of revolutionary change outside of ourselves krishnamurti posits that if the politicians and scientists wanted to end starvation in the world it could be done it could be done but they are not going to do it as long as their thinking is based on nationalism on motives of their own personal profit and even if this far reaching outward change were brought about it seems to me that the problem is much deeper the problem is not merely starvation war the brutality of man to man it is the crisis in our own consciousness fundamentally the problem lies within p 295
