public outcry following the murder of george floyd breonna taylor and other black citizens in the summer of 2020 resulted in a call to shift funding away from police departments and towards social services while previous research has examined perceptions of the defund movement most of this research has focused on perceptions in 2020 this thesis extends prior work by examining changes in perceptions from 2020 and 2022 this was done by analyzing 1 100 reader comments on articles regarding defunding the police from five minneapolis news sources overall i found that perceptions of the defund the police movement did not change substantially from 2020 to 2022 across both years there was a lack of explicit support for defund the

police and modest support for police reforms while there were some shifts in commenters perceptions of blame and their concerns from 2020 to 2022 overall comments centered on fears of crime and employed colorblind arguments to express their disapproval of defunding the police these findings are not consistent with prior public opinion polls gallup 2022 pew research center 2022 and thus point to the complexity of attitudes towards police this is significant as it may help predict future support for policing and police reform movements

the civil unrest of 2020 culminated in numerous american cities pledging to defund the police at the behest of civil rights activists these cities pledged to reallocate funding from municipal police departments into community outreach programs this will be done with the hope of reducing both crime and incidents of police use of force many critics believe the policy will only result in higher rates of crime i collected and observed ten years of panel data across twenty american cities to determine which policy pathway should be followed i analyzed the breakdown of budgets for police and outreach spending and used multiple fixed effects models to see how they correlate with crime statistics and recorded incidents of fatal police shootings i concluded that there are marginal benefits to funding police departments over outreach as a means to reduce crime however funding outreach over police departments has a greater effect on reducing officer involved shootings defunding the police therefore creates only tradeoffs that are not easily measured and compared

abstract following the police killing of george floyd several cities and counties took steps to defund their police in 2020 two years later some law enforcement agencies are facing staffing shortages and low morale among police officers and detectives in hindsight defund the police may follow a trend in which american police reform is often driven by a crisis or major event and results in unintended consequences this study analyzes how a major divestment from police budgets particularly specialist detective units affects criminal investigative operations and detective work using semi structured interviews and transcript data collected from 9 narcotics detectives in the long beach police department this study shows that defund the police has exacerbated existing challenges for narcotics detectives the findings of this study also suggest that some of these challenges can be mitigated through evidence based decision making and adequate support this study provides compelling evidence for
