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the essays in this collection are written to make readers re consider what is possible in africa the essays shake the tree of received wisdom and received categories and hone in on the complexities of life under ecological and economic constraints yet throughout this volume people do not emerge as victims but rather as inventors engineers scientists planners writers artists and activists or as children mothers fathers friends or lovers all as future makers it

is precisely through agents such as these that africa is futuring rethinking living confronting imagining and relating in the light of its many emerging tomorrows

in this book tosin gbogi draws on the rich history of nigerian hip hop and of the long cultural traffic between africa and the african diaspora more broadly to expand our understanding of the culture s central contributions the first comprehensive and systematic study of nigerian hip hop one of the world s oldest and most vibrant of such scenes this book attends to the literary forms the density of ideas historical encounters ideological struggles and the lively internal debates that have animated the culture for more than four decades

chinua achebe's books are being read throughout the english speaking world they have been translated into more than fifty languages his publishers estimate that more than eight million copies of his first novel things fall apart 1958 have been sold as a consequence he is the best known and most widely studied african author his distinguished books of fiction and nonfiction include no longer at ease arrow of god morning yet on creation day christmas in biafra and others achebe often has been called the inventor of the african novel although he modestly denies the title it is true that modern african literature would not have flowered so rapidly and spectacularly had he not led the way by telling africa's story from a distinctively african point of view many other africans have been inspired to write novels by his example the interviews collected here span more than thirty years of achebe's writing career the earliest was recorded in 1962 the latest in 1995 together they offer a representative sample of what he has said to interviewers for newspapers journals and books in many different countries through his own statements we can see achebe as a man of letters a man of ideas a man of words as these interviews show achebe is an impressive speaker and gifted conversationalist who expresses his ideas in language that is simple yet pungent moderate yet peppered with colorful images and illustrations it is this talent for deep and meaningful communication this intimate way with words that makes his interviews a delight to read he has a facility for penetrating to the essence of a question and

framing a response that addresses the concerns of the questioner and sometimes goes beyond those concerns to matters of general interest people he says are expecting from literature serious comment on their lives they are not expecting frivolity they are expecting literature to say something important to help them in their struggle with life this is what literature what art is supposed to do to give us a second handle on reality so that when it becomes necessary to do so we can turn to art and find a way out so it is a serious matter

omali yeshitela is the chairman of the african people s socialist party and leader of the uhuru movement for the majority of his life yeshitela has worked for the liberation of african people he speaks all over the world in his quest to build the african socialist international yeshitela s struggle for a united and liberated africa under the leadership of african workers continues the unfinished legacy of marcus garvey malcolm x and kwame nkrumah in this collection of 28 speeches articles and interviews including the full speech from wolves as heard on the dead prez album let s get free yeshitela emerges as the foremost revolutionary political thinker of our time his analysis from the point of view of the slave is sharp witty and irrefutable

it seems incredible that heretofore there has not been an introductory anthology of african epics presented in english western literary culture has long emphasized the heritage of such well known epics as the iliad the odyssey and aeneid but it is only recently that scholars have turned their attention toward capturing the rich oral tradition that is still alive in africa the twenty five excerpts in this volume have been selected and introduced so as to offer english speaking readers a broad sample of the extensive epic traditions in africa the general introduction and the background on each epic will enable readers to understand the context of each epic and will also provide leads for further inquiry

a major addition to the literature on oral traditions journal of religion in africa this 750 year old epic celebrates the exploits of the legendary founder of the empire of old mali it constitutes a virtual social political and cultural charter and embodies deep rooted aspects of mande cosmology the fully annotated translation is accompanied by an

introduction that provides a historical and contextual framework for understanding the recitation of this african epic

african folk tales have been around for centuries the beauty of africa shines through the stories of creation animals that talk and the wisdom of african proverbs and sayings raymond johnson has collected these stories for years using these stories in his practice as a therapist he discovered while counseling families that by using an opening story it brought calmness and attention while reducing defensiveness of family members this opens to door for future abstract thought development overall these stories enforce the wisdom of the ages from the african continent

pan african wisdom is a quote book series to make the wisdom of and around africa more accessible to more readers there is a saying in africa a counselor who understands proverbs soon sets difficult matters aright each pan african wisdom book focuses on a different topic or era sometimes with overlap but always with the intent to express oft overlooked wisdom and enable african people to embrace reality over fantasy more regularly all can be used as a daily intellectual engagement a referential resource a weekly group study session or a bibliography for wider study into africa pan african wisdom greatest orators is a curated list of quotes from africa s greatest recorded orators from across the pan african world the quotes are attributed and come from a handful of the best speakers and thinkers including marcus garvey julius nyerere carlos a cooks and affiong affiong while not a complete list of orators they mostly speak one language of thousands this book represents ideas all africans should read and is ideal for teenagers and elders and everyone in between

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
