today's trucking era with most railroad stockyards torn down and only one section house left standing writes how I feed on the stories of the hills and the characters who tell them as the cattle feed on the grasses his love of the land shines throughout a book so real that readers will swear they hear the click of horseshoes on flint rock with every turn of the page
