there are more than 225 million rural to urban migrant workers and some 20 million migrant children in chinese cities because of policies related to the household registration hukou system migrant students are not allowed a public high school education in the cities so their urban education stops abruptly at the end of middle school this book investigates the post middle school education and labor market decisions of migrant students in beijing and shanghai and provides a glimpse into the future of a crucial link in china s

development the stories of how these migrant students seek upward mobility and urban citizenship also reveal one of the most intricate structural inequalities in china today based on quantitative data collected from middle schools in beijing and shanghai and ethnographic data drawing on in depth interviews with migrant children their parents and teachers this book offers a portrait of the migration and educational experiences and prospects of second generation migrant youth in china today it explores the urban experience of migrant students contrasting it with that of local city youngsters examining the migrant students family backgrounds family dynamics neighborhood and school experience and interaction with locals it goes on to look at the migrant students education and career aspirations the structural obstacles preventing their fulfilment and how migrant families respond to institutional constraints on educational opportunity finally the book concludes with a discussion of policy implications and offers proposals for resolving the dilemmas of migrant youth this book will of great interest to students and scholars of chinese studies asian education migration and social development

using a nationally representative data set this book examines the characteristics of chinese college students mobility since the expansion of higher education it analyses college graduates mobility in both horizontal and vertical dimensions the horizontal dimension shows college students migration directions and location changes including migration for college migration for employment migration for grassroots positions migration away from the capital and migration back to their hometown the vertical dimension includes students intergenerational occupational mobility and intergenerational regional mobility drawing on theories in education and economics the book provides a solid framework for empirically analysing the characteristics causes and economic and non economic benefits of different forms of mobility this book not only offers insights into china s higher education policies and their impact on the regional and intergenerational mobility decisions of college graduates over the past two decades but also has important implications for other countries at similar stages of social and economic development this book is an excellent read for students and scholars of education economics and east asian studies it can also help policymakers understand the characteristics of students mobility and the underlying reasons for their choices so that they can propose effective policies in the future

after japan s defeat in august 1945 some japanese children were abandoned in china and raised by chinese foster parents they were unable to return to japan even during the mass repatriation carried out by the japanese government in the 1950s most of them

returned to japan in the 1980s they are called japanese war orphans they are victims of the sino japanese war and have been exploited and abandoned by the japanese government they are also border people who have lived in the interstices between two nations china and japan and are migrants who have exploited the gap in economic development between japan and china to seek individual happiness modern east asia underwent drastic social change these drastic social changes affected the lives of the japanese war orphans and their families in a variety of ways over the years zhong has interviewed japanese war orphans their chinese foster parents and japanese volunteers the title is an interview based sociological study of the issue of japanese war orphans the first half of the japanese war orphans lives were spent in china and the latter half in japan it brings to the fore the dramatic personal histories of the japanese war orphans surviving in the interstices between two nation states through analyzing the issue of japanese war orphans the research on the subject makes the following three points 1 the powerlessness of civilians caught up in modern warfare and the long lasting effects of modern warfare on the life histories of individuals and their families 2 the nature of the modern nation state which exploits and abandons its citizens as though they were expendable and 3 immigration as a product of modernization gaps scholars pursuing studies in both japanese society chinese society and historians of the sino japanese war would find this an ideal read

this book centres the voices and agency of migrants by refocusing attention on the diversity and complexity of human mobility when seen from the perspective of people on the move in doing so the volume disrupts the binary logics of migrant refugee push pull and places of origin destination that have informed the bulk of migration research drawn from a range of disciplines and methodologies this anthology links disparate theories approaches and geographical foci to better understand the spectrum of the migratory experience from the viewpoint of migrants themselves the book explores the causes and consequences of human displacement at different scales both individual and community level and across different time points from antiquity to the present and geographies not just the global north but also the global south transnational scholars across a range of knowledge cultures advance a broader global discourse on mobility and migration that centres on the direct experiences and narratives of migrants themselves both interdisciplinary and accessible this book will be useful for scholars and students in migration studies global studies sociology geography and anthropology

the pattern of migrants maintaining strong ties with their home communities is particularly common in sub saharan africa where it has important social cultural political and economic implications this book explores the significance of hometown connections for civil

society and local development in nigeria rich ethnographic description and case studies illustrate the links that the ijesa yoruba maintain with their communities of origin links that both help to shape social identity and contribute to local development trager also examines indigenous concepts of development demonstrating how the yoruba bring their understandings of development to efforts in their own communities placing her work in the context of national political and economic change she raises questions about the motivations implications and consequences of local development efforts not only for the communities and their members but also for the larger polity

in one of the most remote covert campaigns of the cold war the cia harnessed nurtured and encouraged the khampa tribesmen of tibet in their defiance against chinese subjugation this is the first time the story has been told

between 1867 the year of the alaskan purchase and the beginning of world war i russian and american dignitaries diplomats businessmen writers tourists and entertainers crossed between the two countries in surprisingly great numbers concord and conflict provides the first comprehensive investigation of this highly transformational and fateful era in russian american relations excavating previously unmined russian and american archives norman saul illuminates these fifty significant and open years of association between the two countries he explores the flow and fluctuation of economic diplomatic social and cultural affairs the personal and professional conflicts and scandals and the evolution of each nation s perception of the other

when soldiers in the civil war called on their religious beliefs in order to cope with the horrors of battle many looked to the regimental chaplain for guidance and understanding clergy were always present to address the spiritual needs of the common soldier and administer to the wounded and dying but as warren armstrong shows military chaplains provided more than comfort in a country profoundly shaped by religion each side adapted its version of christianity to support its political views this book documents the role

played by union chaplains in making better soldiers and supporting the north's military efforts these ministers in uniform focused on preserving the union and reminding soldiers that slavery was the central issue in the war preaching the righteousness of abolition in services held in the mud of campgrounds and often serving as advocates for freedmen armstrong has drawn on a wide range of documents to explain the duties of union chaplains and differentiate them from their southern counterparts he examines the organization of the chaplaincy and reviews its manuals for guidelines on such matters as cultivating desirable character traits and building makeshift churches he also sheds light on the personalities of the men who served examines their attitudes toward the war and assesses their unofficial role as morale officers for the union army wherever possible armstrong uses chaplains letters diaries and written reports to explain their thoughts and actions in their own words his book is narrative history with a richly human element including such episodes as a chaplain who took a fallen soldier's place and died in battle and two chaplains of different faiths who slept together for warmth on a cold winter night at fredericksburg before the civil war the need for a military chaplaincy had been challenged on the grounds of separation of church and state but the valiant service of chaplains during that conflict helped prove their worth and establish a lasting military tradition in relating their story armstrong's work faithfully documents the contributions chaplains made both to the union victory and to the form that victory took

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
