recipient of a 2018 preserve louisiana award and a 2018 coastal stewardship award fragile grounds compiles stories and photographs of endangered cemeteries throughout louisiana's coastal zone and beyond these burial places link the fragile land to the frailty of the state s threatened community structures the book highlights the state s vibrant diversity by showing its unique burial customs and traditions while it also identifies the urgent need for ongoing documentation of cultural elements at risk cemeteries associated with the culturally rich communities of louisiana reflect the history and global settlement patterns of the state yet many are endangered due to recurring natural and man made events nearly 80 percent of the nation s coastal land loss occurs in louisiana coastal erosion sinking land flooding storm surge and sea level rise have led to an inland migration that threatens to unravel the fabric of louisiana and by association hastens the demise of its burial places as people are forced inland migrants abandon neglect or often overlook cemeteries as part of the cultural landscape in terms of erosion when the land goes the cemetery goes with it cemeteries fall prey to inland and coastal flooding as cities grow outward urban sprawl takes over the landscape cemeteries lose out to forces such as expansion eminent domain and urban neglect not only do cemeteries give comfort for the living but they also serve as a vital link to the past once lost that past cannot be recovered

winner of the 2018 louisiana literary award given by the louisiana library association for centuries outlanders have openly denigrated louisiana's coastal wetlands residents and their stubborn refusal to abandon the region's fragile prairies tremblants despite repeated natural and more recently man made disasters yet the cumulative environmental knowledge these wetlands survivors have gained through painful experiences over the course of two centuries holds invaluable keys to the successful adaptation of modern coastal communities throughout the globe as hurricane sandy recently demonstrated coastal peoples everywhere face rising sea levels

disastrous coastal erosion and inevitably difficult lifestyle choices along the bayou state s coast the most insidious challenges are man made since channelization of the mississippi river in the wake of the 1927 flood which diverted sediments and nutrients from the wetlands coastal louisiana has lost to erosion subsidence and rising sea levels a land mass roughly twice the size of connecticut state and national policymakers were unable to reverse this environmental catastrophe until hurricane katrina focused a harsh spotlight on the human consequences of eight decades of neglect yet even today the welfare of louisiana s coastal plain residents remains at best an afterthought in state and national policy discussions for coastal families the gulf water lapping at the doorstep makes this morass by no means a scholarly debate over abstract problems ain t there no more renders an easily read history filled with new insights and possibilities rare previously unpublished images documenting a disappearing way of life accompany the narrative the authors bring nearly a century of combined experience to distilling research and telling this story in a way invaluable to louisianans to policymakers and to all those concerned with rising sea levels and seeking a long term solution

born into poverty in mississippi at the close of the nineteenth century charley patton and jimmie rodgers established themselves among the most influential musicians of their era in tune tells the story of the parallel careers of these two pioneering recording artists one white one black who moved beyond their humble origins to change the face of american music at a time when segregation formed impassable lines of demarcation in most areas of southern life music transcended racial boundaries jimmie rodgers and charley patton drew inspiration from musical traditions on both sides of the racial divide and their songs about hard lives raising hell

and the hope of better days ahead spoke to white and black audiences alike their music reflected the era in which they lived but evoked a range of timeless human emotions as the invention of the phonograph disseminated traditional forms of music to a wider audience jimmie rodgers gained fame as the father of country music while patton s work eventually earned him the title king of the delta blues patton and rodgers both died young leaving behind a relatively small number of recordings though neither remains well known to mainstream audiences the impact of their contributions echoes in the songs of today the first book to compare the careers of these two musicians in tune is a vital addition to the history of american music
